REBECCA MARTINEZ, County Clerk-Recorder and Registrar of Voters announced today that in order to be eligible to vote in the November 4, 2014 Statewide General Election, persons must register to vote by Monday, October 20, 2014.

In order to be eligible to register to vote, a person must be a United States Citizen, live in Madera County and be 18 years old on or before Election Day. Registered voters who have moved, changed their name, or wish to change their political party must re-register by October 20th.

Voter registration cards are available at the County Clerk's office (call to request a card by mail or come in), local Post Offices, local Libraries, or register to vote online at www.votemadera.com or www.registertovote.ca.gov.

The County Clerk's office will be open until 6pm on October 20, 2014 to accept voter registration cards.
