SUBJECT: Notice of Election – Special Recall Election

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to the qualified electors of the Golden Valley Unified District, Trustee Areas 1, 2, & 4, in the County of Madera, that a Special Recall Election will be held Tuesday, September 1, 2015. The following question shall appear on the ballot in each respective trustee area:

Shall CARLA NEAL be recalled (removed) from the office of Governing Board Member, Area 1? Shall KATHLEEN CRUMPTON be recalled (removed) from the office of Governing Board Member, Area 2? Shall JOHN MOSELEY be recalled (removed) from the office of Governing Board Member, Area 4?

Voters may mark either “Yes” or “No” however, voters need not vote on the recall question in order to vote for a candidate to succeed the officer sought to be recalled.

If a majority of voters voting on the recall question vote “Yes”, the incumbent shall be removed from office upon certification of the election results and swearing in of his/her successor. If the Incumbent is recalled, the candidate receiving the greatest number of votes shall be elected to the incumbent’s unexpired term. There is no run-off election.

Below the recall question, will appear the names of the candidates who have filed to seek election to the office in the event the recall is successful.

Pursuant to Elections Code §11381(c), the Incumbent may not be a candidate to succeed himself/herself or any other member of the same governing board that is also the subject of recall however, he/she may submit a statement for publication in the sample ballot booklet. Statements must be filed no later than 5pm on the last day of candidate filing (June 5, 2015).

The following are the filing periods associated with becoming a candidate for the offices listed above:

- May 11, 2015 to June 5, 2015 Declaration of Candidacy Filing Period
- May 11, 2015 to June 5, 2015 Statement by Incumbent Filing Period
- July 6, 2015 to August 18, 2015 Write-in Candidacy Period

* - indicates date falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or Holiday. Filing date moves to next business day.

Interested candidates must obtain and file the required documentation to run for office from the County Clerk-Recorder, located at 200 W 4th Street, Madera California. The County Clerk-Recorder will issue and file documents during normal business hours, Monday through Friday, during each of the filing period listed above.

The elections official shall make a copy of the materials submitted available for public examination in her office for a period of 10 calendar days immediately following the filing deadline for the submission of those documents. Any person may obtain a copy of the materials from the elections official. The elections official may charge a fee to any person obtaining a copy of the material. The fee may not exceed the actual cost incurred by the elections official in providing the copy.

The boundaries of the voting precincts within the County, the location of the polling places, and the names of the officers selected to conduct the election, shall be determined by the Registrar of Voters of Madera County. On Election Day, the polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
