Rebecca Martinez, County Clerk-Recorder and Registrar of Voters reminds voters that all voters can vote in a primary election.

Voting for President depends on the party you are registered with.

If you are registered with a Political Party:

You can vote for a candidate running for President in that party.

If you are registered with no party preference:

You can vote in the Presidential Primary for the following parties:

- Democratic
- American Independent
- Libertarian

You can select the party ballot at your polling place. If you vote by mail, a notice has already been sent to you.

If you are registered with no party preference and want to vote in the Presidential Primary for one of the following political parties:

- Republican
- Green
- Peace & Freedom.

You must re-register to vote with that party by **May 23, 2016**.
