NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the **General Services Department, County of Madera, California**, acting by and through its Governing Board, hereinafter referred to as the County, will receive up to, but not later than **2:00:00 p.m., PDT, Thursday, August 25, 2016**, sealed bids for the award of a contract for: Project: Madera County Probation Boot Camp

PROJECT LOCATION: 28219 Avenue 14, Madera California 93638

MANDATORY PRE BID CONFERENCE: A mandatory pre-bid meeting has been scheduled **Tuesday, August 2, 2016 @ 10:00 AM** to review the Project's existing conditions. The pre-bid meeting will take place at the project site located at 28219 Avenue 14, Madera, CA 93638. **Only those prime contractors attending the pre-bid conference shall be permitted to bid the work.**

EXAMINATION OF SITE: Each bidder shall examine the site of work before bidding and shall be responsible for having acquired full knowledge of the job and of all problems affecting it. No variations or allowances from the contract sum will be made because of lack of such examination.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Construction consists of modernization of 16,667 S.F. Probation Boot Camp Facility, interior finishes, framing, doors, casework, new restrooms & showers, modification of existing restrooms to current accessible standards. Including new electrical, mechanical, plumbing fixtures/systems and site work.

CONSTRUCTION COST ESTIMATE: \$2,118,717

CONTRACTORS LICENSE: The Contractor shall possess a valid California Class B license at the time this Project is bid. Each bidder shall be a licensed contractor pursuant to the Business and Professions Code and shall be licensed in the appropriate classification(s) of contractor's license(s), for the work bid upon, and must maintain the license throughout the duration of the Contract.

QUESTIONS: All contractual and technical questions should be directed to the, Project Manager, Maritza Rodriguez maritza.rodriguez@co.madera.ca.gov. Questions shall be submitted on the "REQUEST FOR CLARIFICATION" form provided in the Contract Documents.

BID DOCUMENTS: Each bid must conform and be responsive to the Contract Documents and all plans, specifications and any other documents pertaining to the Project, copies of which are now on file and may be obtained after June 13, 2016. Contractors may request plans, specifications, and proposal forms for bidding this project from the Project Manager, Maritza Rodriguez at (559) 675-7703 or maritza.rodriguez@co.madera.ca.gov.

BID SUBMITTAL INSTRUCTION: Bids shall be received in the office of the County of Madera, County Administrative Office, General Services Department, 200 West 4th Street, 4th Floor Suite 4200, Madera, California 93637, Attn.: Luz Gonzalez and shall be opened and publicly read aloud at the above-stated time.

PAYMENT AND PERFORMANCE BOND: The successful bidder will be required to furnish the County with a Performance Bond equal to 100% of the successful bid, and a Payment Bond equal to 100% of the successful bid, prior to execution of the Contract. All bonds are to be secured from a surety company that meets all of the State of California bonding requirements, as defined in Code of Civil Procedure Section 995.120, and is authorized by the State of California, and all documents required by Code of Civil Procedure Section 995.660, to the extent required by law.

SUBSTITUTION OF SECURITIES: Pursuant to the provisions of Public Contract Code Section 22300, the successful bidder may substitute certain securities for funds withheld by County to ensure his performance under the Contract. At the request and expense of the successful bidder, securities equivalent to any amount withheld shall be deposited at the discretion of County, with either County or a state or federally chartered bank, as the escrow agent, who shall then pay any funds otherwise subject to retention to the successful bidder. Upon satisfactory completion of the Contract, the securities shall be returned to the successful bidder.

PREVAILING WAGES: The Director of Industrial Relations has determined the general prevailing rate of per diem wages in the locality in which this work is to be performed for each craft or type of worker needed to execute the Contract which will be awarded to the successful bidder, copies of which are on file and will be made available to any interested party upon request. A copy of these rates shall be posted at the job site.

It shall be mandatory upon the bidder to whom the Contract is awarded, and upon any subcontractor under him, to comply with all Labor Code provisions, which include, but are not limited to the payment of not less than the said specified rates to all workers employed by them in the execution of the Contract, employment of apprentices, hours of labor and debarment of contractors and subcontractors.

REGISTRATION: This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations. No contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal for a public works project, or awarded a contract for public work on a public works project, unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5. The County shall not accept a bid or enter into a contract without proof of contractor's and subcontractor's current registration. All contractors must furnish electronic certified payroll records to the Labor Commissioner in the eCPR data system, or equivalent as authorized by the Labor Commissioner.

WITHDRAWAL OF BIDS: The County reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any irregularities or informalities in any bids or in the bidding. No bidder may withdraw his/her bid for a period of sixty (60) days after the date set for the opening thereof.

BID SELECTION: The County shall award the Contract for the Project to the bidder submitting the responsive lowest bid as determined from the base bid, and is deemed responsible by the County.

CONSTRUCTION TIME: The successful CONTRACTOR (after receiving the Notice to Proceed) shall have **one hundred and eighty (180)** calendar days to complete all work called for under the Contract Documents.

LIQUIDATED DAMAGES: The liquidated damages will be **\$500.00** per day for the project delays that are determined to be attributable to the CONTRACTOR.
