VOTE BY MAIL – DEADLINE TO RETURN VOTED BALLOTS:

Voters receiving their ballots by mail are urged to vote and return the ballot by not later than 8pm on Election Day, Tuesday, November 4th.

On Election Day, voters may return voted ballots to any polling place in the county or deliver it to the office of the County Clerk-Recorder, located at 200 W. 4th Street, Madera. A complete list of polling locations is available on our website.

Vote by Mail ballots cannot be counted if they are received after 8pm on Election Day.
