Question #1

Can Companies from outside the United States of America apply for this?

Response to Question #1

The Request For Proposals does not stipulate the country of origin for equipment, software or service. Accordingly, the country of origin will not be a consideration when evaluating responses.

Question #2

Will attendance at meetings in Madera County be required?

Response to Question #2

Madera County reserves the right to require in-person meetings, in our office located at 200 West Fourth Street, Madera, CA with any or all organizations submitting a response to the RFP.

Question #3

Can the tasks (related to the RFP) be performed outside of the U.S.A.?

Response to Question #3

While the RFP does not stipulate where certain work will be performed the County Of Madera expects that, when necessary (in the opinion of the County of Madera), work will be performed onsite (Madera, CA).

Can proposals be submitted via "email?"

Is the New Voting System RFP the correct forum for "Ballot Printing on Demand" providers to respond?
